Message From The Rear Commodore Jane Thomas



Please **congratulate our Parade of Lights committee** for their successful efforts in achieving 2nd Place among the Yacht Club entries on Saturday, December 8! This year's theme was *HOLIDAYS IN TOYLAND*. After a change of platform to Tim Smith's Yacht fisher 51, Dann Daggett came up with a unique concept. We started with a cresting wave at the stern and light boxes with **"CIYC, The Ocean is Our Toyland"** and alternating lighted outlines of a Sailboat, Powerboat, and Kayak amid ships and on the foredeck, respectively. Below the wave we added backlights and fluorescent-painted fish to a black background "underwater" scene. Numerous members helped with the execution: Tim Smith created the arc that defined the height and curve of the wave; Bill Crocket, Dann Daggett, and Mike Farrell created the light boxes and black light brackets; Dann programmed all the light sequencing; Jack Borkowski procured the sound system; Graham Paine, Frank Sullivan, Dick Olsen, and Dave Erickson prepared the generators loaned by Graham, Carol Lazzarevich, and Sherrie Brisbane. Sherie Ireland spent hours and hours painting and mounting the fluorescent fish with assistance from Joyce Sheridan, Cindy Arosteguy and Jennifer Sparks. Curt Ingram found the music to tie it all together: "I Saw Santa in his Bathing Suit", an upbeat fantasy song with Santa as a surfer who tried to catch a wave but missed; in our black light display Santa was swimming under the wave at the stern. Keith Moore made a run to Home Depot for materials; Bill Crocket, Dave Erickson, Tom Warden, Sherie Ireland, Mary Foster, Karen Farrell, Joyce Sheridan, Jennifer Sparks, Tim Smith, and many others helped with assembly on the boat. Tim drove the boat while Rick Ireland, Kyle Crocket, and Mary Foster kept a lookout. Jennifer, dressed in her fluorescent wetsuit, danced on the bow and waved to the fans while Dave maintained the generators and Dann and Mike oversaw the electronics (lights and sound, respectively).

Angler's dues of \$10 for the 2013 fishing season are now due. Please send in your Angler's dues with your regular club dues billing. If you forgot and sent the dues in without the anglers' dues you can provide a SEPARATE check made out to "**Channel Islands Yacht Club, Anglers**" and put **Anglers Dues** in the memo section of the check and send it or bring it to the Club.

We intend for this to be an exciting and fun filled year. If you are a current member you know the drill but for those of you who are new and may want to join in the fun here are the details:

For only ten bucks you will have a distinctive looking fish next to your name in the CIYC roster; participate in the Club's Tournaments, be eligible for the **\$50 Big Fish of the Month Award**, as well as the **\$100 Big Fish of the Year Award**.

Many months go-by when no, or few fish are weighed in which means that the ¼ lb mackerel may be worth \$50, so weigh him in! An Angler can only win the monthly prize once a year so we should have 12 different winners.

Anglers Club funds have, in the past been used for projects around the Yacht Club and for the betterment of our fishing experience, and to support the White Seabass grow out pens in the harbor.
