It is all about being the very best you can be.


The projects and issues that were of vital importance in the beginning soon became endless surprises.

#### "Suddenly in Command" Course Offered

The Coast Guard Auxiliary is offering the course "Suddenly In Command" on Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup> from 9:00am to 11:30am. It will be held at the Pacific Corinthian Yacht Club, 2600 S. Harbor Blvd., Oxnard.

No one considers the possibility that the Captain of a vessel could become disabled or incapacitated leaving those on the vessel without an operator. Unfortunately, this happens far to often. This  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hour course is designed for anyone who goes out on the water and finds themselves "Suddenly In Command".

The course instructors are from the Coast Guard Auxiliary and will cover emergency procedures which will include:

- Communications: How to operate a marine radio and make a call for help to the Coast Guard.
- Knowing your location: Being able to transmit it to the Coast Guard.
- Operation of a vessel: Starting, stopping, and maneuvering.
- Action to be taken in case of fire.
- Man overboard, capsizing and swamping.

This course is intended to save lives and you are urged to attend. There will be **no charge** for this course.

James Murdick from Hubbs Sea World Research Institute trucked up a load of about 2900 WSB for the Growout pens. The truck was met by a group of CIYC members and friends including; Frank Sullivan, Skip Miser, Tim Haapanen and Diane, Dick Olsen, new members- Eric Ireland, Don and Cathy Dickey, Dave Wardlow and friends of CIYC-Charlie and Colin Farrell, and Hilal Helweh. There were some others there as well sorry if I missed you.


The Delivery went very well, with a new method which entailed transporting the fish in plastic barrels to the pens and slowly lowering the fish into the water this insured much less trauma to these delicate fish and a better chance of survival. The transfer went very quickly due to all the help.

The feeders were setup and everything looked good. However I got a call the next day from Hilal Helweh to let me know that due to operator error (mine) the feeders had completely emptied on the first feeding. That problem was quickly corrected. Then, two days later I got a call from Don Dickey, the boat next to the pens had an oil spill and we had to put out oil pads to absorb as much as possible.

Due to the early trauma we lost about 30 fish the first few days but have lost every few since then. The fish are looking healthy and feeding well. Thank you to all who have helped these last few months. We finally have fish, now the real work begins. It will be worth it when we get to release them in the spring.






