Skip Miser and Eric Ireland did a short run down the coast in search of fish and were successful. Eric's White Sea Bass weighed 47.2 lbs. and Skip's Halibut weighed 44.8 lbs. They caught them down off shore County Line area August 14th. Skip said there were four light boats set up on top of the squid and it was easy to jig them up. These are the only two bites they got, they quit fishing after that. Skip said it was 'Plenty of meat for us'.



Big Fish of the month:

So far it looks like Skip Miser's 44.8 lbs. Halibut will be the Big Fish of the month for August.

CIBFT:

The Channel Islands Bill Fish Tournament is this month. So far we have 3 boats competing in the **tourney: the veteran Marlin fisherman "Skip" Miser on the *Dawn Patrol*** with an experienced crew, novice Marlin fisherman Frank Sullivan on the ***Valkyrie*** with an inexperienced (at marlin fishing anyway) crew, and Don Johnson with Dixie Redden as Crew on the ***Margaritaville***.

After three years of relatively cool water and few marlin to be caught, this year looks to be a great change, with prognosis of a warm-water El Nino season and reports of several releases already.

Frank Sullivan's *Valkyrie* escorted a San Diego canoe in the Hawaiian Outrigger Canoe Race, held on Saturday, August 25th. Sixteen canoes hailing from Santa Barbara to San Diego participated. The triangular course started and ended in Channel Islands Harbor, rounding a buoy near the power station toward Ventura, then a buoy near oil rig Gilda - a distance of about 23 miles. Each canoe had a team of 12: 6 men and 6 women, and each canoe was escorted by a volunteer power boat. Six team members paddled for 30 minutes, after which there was a 5-minute period for a switch from men to women, women to men, and so forth, for the duration of the 4-hour race. As our skipper, Frank, expertly maneuvered into position ahead of our canoe, the 6 team members aboard *Valkyrie* dove into the water, swam toward the canoe, lined up, and prepared to board their canoe as the six paddlers on the canoe jumped into the ocean and swam to us, their escort boat. It was a very exciting and interesting race to witness. Don Dickey and Carey Verstynen helped the team members board our boat, throwing out lines and helping to haul them in. Zoran Barbaric served as spotter for Frank. We estimated an average speed of nearly 6 knots was attained by our wonderful canoe team - great young guys and girls - and they did very well, finishing in third place. **Contributed by Zoran and Erika**





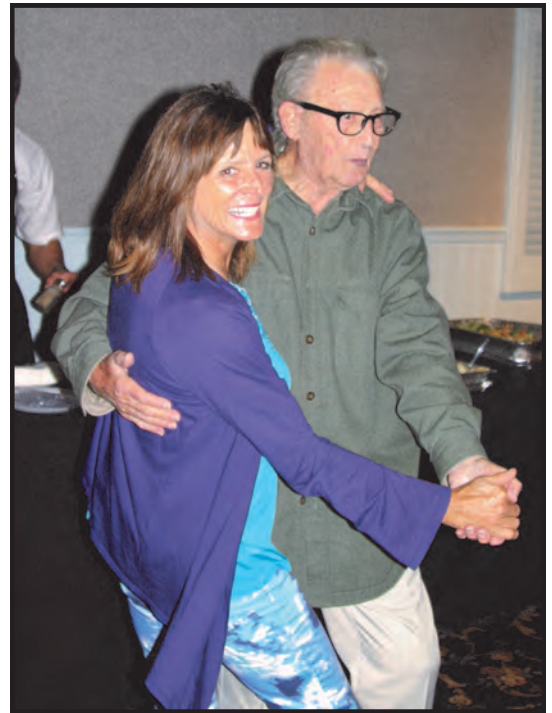
