










Anglers' Corner

At the end of the year there will be a Big Fish of the Year award for \$100.00 it does not have to be one of the monthly winners, it can be a tourney fish or not, so if you win one month don't quit, the next fish you catch may be worth \$\$S\$\$

Don Dickey got tired of waiting for the Ocean fishing to heat up in February so he tried his hand at fishing Lake Casitas and came up with this very nice trout, winning the big fish award for February. Remember, if you are a CIYC Anglers' Club member, you can win \$50.00 if you bring in the biggest <u>Legal</u> fish of the month, sharks and rays do not count. You can only win once a year, but as the Lotto people are fond of saying,, "you can't win if you don't play".

There is a scale in the shed near the ice machine. All you have to do is weight the fish in with a CIYC club member or bartender as witness then record the weight. Put the recorded weight in the Anglers mail box in the hall down stairs. If you like, call me on my Cell 805-205-4073 and I will witness your catch and take a photo for the Currents.
