

### Message From The Rear Commodore Jane Thomas



July 2012

June was a busy month on the water! It started with the **Bob Cooke Double-Handed (only 2 people aboard)** Race on Saturday, June 2. Bill Brayton was the PRO, Woody Underwood piloted ABSOLUT as the Committee boat, and Bonnie Chaney, Ginny Matthews, Tom Warden, and I assisted Bill as the Race Committee. The perpetual trophy will acknowledge ANGRY HILLBILLIES as the winner for Spinnaker class and Randy Alcorn (OUT PA-TIENT) for Non-Spinnaker class; second and third places went to Joe Joines (TUNZAGRUNT) and ABRACA-DABRA (spinnaker) and Harry Krum (FUSÉE) and Brent Swanson (VELERO) in non-spinnaker class, respective-

On Sunday, June 10, Betty Larson and Deborah (Larson) Tyhurst hosted the John Larson Memorial Race and after-party, sharing his favorite rum with all skippers and crew as well as stories about John. Nearly all entries were CIYC members and included Rick and Deborah Tyhurst (EAU CLAIRE), Zoran Barbaric (TOMAHAWK), and Dennis West (WEST WING), as well as frequent racers, Tom Warshauer (QUIET TIMES), Shelly Johnson (ZOARCES), and Chris Johnston (BREEZY). In an attempt to make the boats finish close together, we held a "pursuit race," i.e., the boat with the largest PHRF handicap (theoretically the slowest boat) started first. The rest of the boats' start times were pre-calculated by PHRF handicap relative to the slowest boat and the length of the race, and the first boat to finish is the winner. The small, lighter boats prevailed in the light winds around Gina. Joes Joines single-handed his Melges 24 TUNZAGRUNT to first place overall and non-spinnaker class, and Chris Johnston won first in Spinnaker class and second overall. Second and third places went to Tom Warshauer (QUIET TIMES) and Shelly Johnson (ZOARCES) in spinnaker class and Zoran Barbaric (TOMAHAWK) and Rick Tyhurst (EAU CLAIRE) in non-spinnaker class, respectively. An outbound freighter from Port Hueneme demanded that ZOARCES get out of its way, and she obliged but lost her position against the other spinnaker boats. Special thanks to Woody Underwood and Tom Warden for helping me on the Race Committee boat.

Unfortunately, the Channel Islands to Marina del Rey Race did not occur again this year. CIYC and Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club collaborate to produce this event, which was initiated by Paul Hatcher in the '80s and attended by 30 or more boats with lots of partying at both ends. CIYC hosts the pre-race dinner and breakfast as well as the race start, and SMWYC hosts the race finish and dinner and breakfast thereafter. The race date didn't jive between Marina del Rey and Channel Islands Harbor calendars as published by SCYA, and the last-minute change to the MDR published date led to confusion and crew problems such that the number of entries was very low and the boats very disparate, so the race was cancelled for this year. The SMWYC Race Chair and I have vowed to resurrect the CI to MDR race in 2013, coordinate our calendars early, and make it a great race again.

On June 16-17, Channel Islands Marina and other local vendors hosted the first MARINAFEST in Channel Islands Harbor, replacing the larger boat show and green expo of recent years. Lots of boats and brokers were present, as well as representatives of other vendors and associations. CIYC was represented by Dana Hamilton who helped with the table set-up, and Keith Moore, Harry Krum, Chris Williams, Les Hardwick, Bonnie Chaney, Mary Howard, Curt Ingram, and Graham Paine who greeted attendees at the MARINAFEST and invited them to CIYC's Open House, where Jerry and DeAnn Wood, Cary Verstynen, and others welcomed the visitors and showed them around the club.

On Saturday, June 30, Port Captain Gary and Joyce Johnson, together with their neighbor, Carol Lazzarevich, are hosting the **first dinghy party of the 2012 season**. Gary and Vice Commodore, Tom Warden, have planned for a fun afternoon with great food and live music.

We have no CIYC-sponsored races in July, but watch for news about the Fry's Harbor Cruise, Postponed from July 6-8 to a future date, and the Ladies' and Men's Fishing tourneys at the end of the month.

"THIS IS WHAT CIYC IS ABOUT". People kept telling me they had a really good time!!! SUCCESS!!!!! Thank you all for your support.






