Beverly Hamilton **HISTORIAN**

My husband, Bob and I joined the Channel Islands Yacht Club in 1973 and have accumulated many photos and Currents over the years. Along with the photo albums at the Clubhouse, I feel I can do a pretty good job of telling about some of the fun and interesting events of our Club.

Following are excerpts from an article written by then Historian Helen Castle and printed in the Reporter. In 1959 several men interested in boating organized the Channel Island Yacht Club. Incorporated in 1960 with 20 charter members, they held their meetings at the Beach Chamber of Commerce building. Some of the members were Ralph McKeehan, Claude Castle, Vince Doud, and Jim Donlon. Herbert Catlin was our first Commodore in 1960.

There was no marina or boat slips then. The official opening of the Harbor was in May, 1965. The first Parade of Lights was sponsored by CIYC with a parade of decorated boats. The Club joined the Southern California Yachting Association and moved to their own club quarters pictured here. It was one room with a bar at one end. There were open decks on either side. The Bartender was Luella Butler and she ran the bar with an iron hand.



The Channel Islanders were organized in 1965 with Helen Castle installed as the First Mate. The Islanders were formed to help the Big Club by holding Flea Markets, Fashion Shows, and fundraising dinners. They also were in charge of the decorating and food for Opening Days.

The first Opening day was held in June 1969 under Commodore Ben Faulkner. It was a grand sight to see all the members in their white pants and blue blazers.

In 1970 Commodore Bob Dryden started Saturday Night Dinners at the club prepared by volunteer members. This is a tradition that has prevailed until today.

Through the years the club grew quickly and events were added such as fishing tournaments, predicted log races, sailboat races, and day and weekend cruises. Later on I will tell about some of the activities and stories over the years.

Angler's dues of \$10 for the 2011 fishing season are now due. Please send in your dues with your regular club dues billing. If you forgot and sent it in without the anglers' dues you can provide a SEPARATE check made out to Channel Islands Yacht Club and put Anglers Club in the memo section of the check and send it or bring it to the Club.

We intend for this to be an exciting and fun filled year. If you are a current member you know the drill but for those of you who are new and may want to join in the fun here are the details:

For only ten bucks you will have a distinctive looking fish next to your name in the CIYC roster; participate in the Club's Tournaments, be eligible for the **\$50 Big Fish of the Month Award**, as well as the **\$100 Big Fish of the Year Award** (this year \$150, because Don Dickey donated his big fish winnings for November to this year's Big Fish of the Year prize).

Many months go-by when no, or few fish are weighed in which means that the ¼ lb mackerel may be worth \$50, so weigh him in! An Angler can only win the monthly prize once a year so we should have 12 different winners.

Anglers Club funds have, in the past been used for projects around the Yacht Club and for the betterment of our fishing experience, and to support the White Seabass grow out pens in the harbor.

Last year the Anglers donated money for the Opening Day outdoor music by the British Brass, misc. computer parts for the office and material for the White Sea Bass Pen rehab.

This year I am soliciting ideas from the members on how to improve the services of the Anglers Club. We will again have an In-Harbor fishing tournament, Ladies Fishing Tournament and Men's Fishing Tournament. Please enclose a indicating your interest or any other ideas to benefit the welfare of the Club.

If you wish to join this elite group please respond by January 30th so we can put the fish logo by your name in the CIYC Roster.

WSB grow out pen update:

James Murdick from Hubs Sea World Research Institute (HSWI) came to the pens in December to sample the fish and get their length weight and health. Most of the fish were doing very well, just a few had bubble eye and some bird strikes.

While he was there we were able to reattach the bottom tag line in pen #2 with the help of Don Dickey. When pulling up the bottom of the nets with the tag lines please lift the anchors first to relieve the strain on the net fabric.

Hilal Helweh has arranged for a friend who is a diver to inspect the predator net to make sure the cormorants are not getting in through a hole in the net.

All in all James said we are in good shape so far this year.

Thanks to Collin Farrell, for filling in for Bob Deyling while Bob is in Hawaii. Welcome Zoran Barbaric as a new alternate on the WSB feeding schedule.

Community First Counseling Center is a non-profit (501 C 3) charitable organization founded in 2004 to meet the counseling and psychotherapy needs of uninsured people in Ventura County. As many folks know, few health care options exist for people in the community who lack resources or health insurance. If one's income does not fall below the poverty level to qualify for federally supported programs, options are very limited. Community members who work at low paid jobs or who may have lost their jobs in this difficult economy are particularly vulnerable. Without needed mental health counseling, they may become debilitated, unable to return to work, or unable to continue working. CFCC attempts to meet these needs by providing mental health services funded with grants, donations, fund raisers, and a modest sliding fee scale. No one is ever turned away for inability to pay.

Since opening our doors in 2004, 125 clients have received much needed individual or family counseling services. By the end of 2010, two interns will have earned the all of the required 3000 hours of supervised experience that will qualify them to become licensed as Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW's) or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists (MFT's). All this is accomplished on a shoe string budget with board members donating talent and resources for all administrative functions. We are proud of the good quality of care we provide to a gravely underserved population in the community.

Thank you to CIYC members for your participation and generosity. It was a fun day!

A special thanks to Sharon Sullivan for wisdom and support with planning and implementing the event. Thanks to Bonnie Chaney for the generous donation of beautiful handcrafted jewelry items that generated fierce competition and money! Thank you to those club members who made donations and for attending and participating in a fun filled day.

On behalf of the entire board of directors for Community First Counseling Center, Nancy Latham and I say thank you to the entire club. We are very proud to be members of a community services oriented yacht club and look forward to 2011.
