Anglers' Corner

Angler's dues of \$10 for the 2012 fishing season are now due. Please send in your dues with your regular club dues billing. If you forgot and sent the dues in without the anglers' dues, you can write a SEPARATE check made out to "Channel Islands Yacht Club, Anglers" and put Anglers' Dues in the memo section of the check and send it or bring it to the Club.

We intend for this to be an exciting and fun-filled year. If you are a current member, you know the drill; but for those of you who are new and may want to join in the fun, here are the details:

For only ten bucks, you will have a distinctive looking fish next to your name in the CIYC roster, participate in the Club's Tournaments, and be eligible for the **\$50 Big Fish-of-the-Month Award**, as well as the **\$100 Big Fish-of-the-Year Award**.

Many months go by when no, or few, fish are weighed-in which means that the ¼-lb mackerel may be worth \$50, so weigh him in! An Angler can only win the monthly prize once a year, so we should have 12 different winners.

Anglers' Club funds have, in the past, been used for projects around the Yacht Club, for the betterment of our fishing experience, and to support the White Seabass grow-out pens in the harbor.

Last year the Anglers donated money for the Opening Day outdoor music by the British Brass, Coffee-serving rack, two new bar stools, and material for the White Sea Bass Pen rehab.

As always, I am soliciting ideas from the members on how to improve the services of the Anglers Club. We will again have an In-Harbor fishing tournament, Ladies Fishing Tournament and Men's Fishing Tournament. Please enclose a note indicating your interest or any other ideas to benefit the welfare of the Club.

If you wish to join this elite group please respond by January 30th so we can put the **fish logo** by your name in the CIYC Roster.

WSB grow out pen update:

Kenton Finkbeiner from Hubs Sea World Research Institute (HSWI) came to the pens in December to sample the fish and get their length, weight and health. Most of the fish were doing very well, **just a few** had bubble eye and some bird strikes.

He has asked that the Pen monitors, AKA Fish Daddies, aggressively cull sick and damaged fish so they don't infect the healthy ones. All in all, Kenton said we are in good shape so far this year.

Remember Rock Fish season is closed from January 1st until March 1st!

Turn in your Big (or not so big) fish for the Big Fish-of-the-Month contest and \$50.00.

Tim Haapanen has the **big fish of the month so far in December** with a 1 ½ lb. Rock fish. He caught larger ones but didn't think about the Big Fish contest until he had filleted the bigger ones.

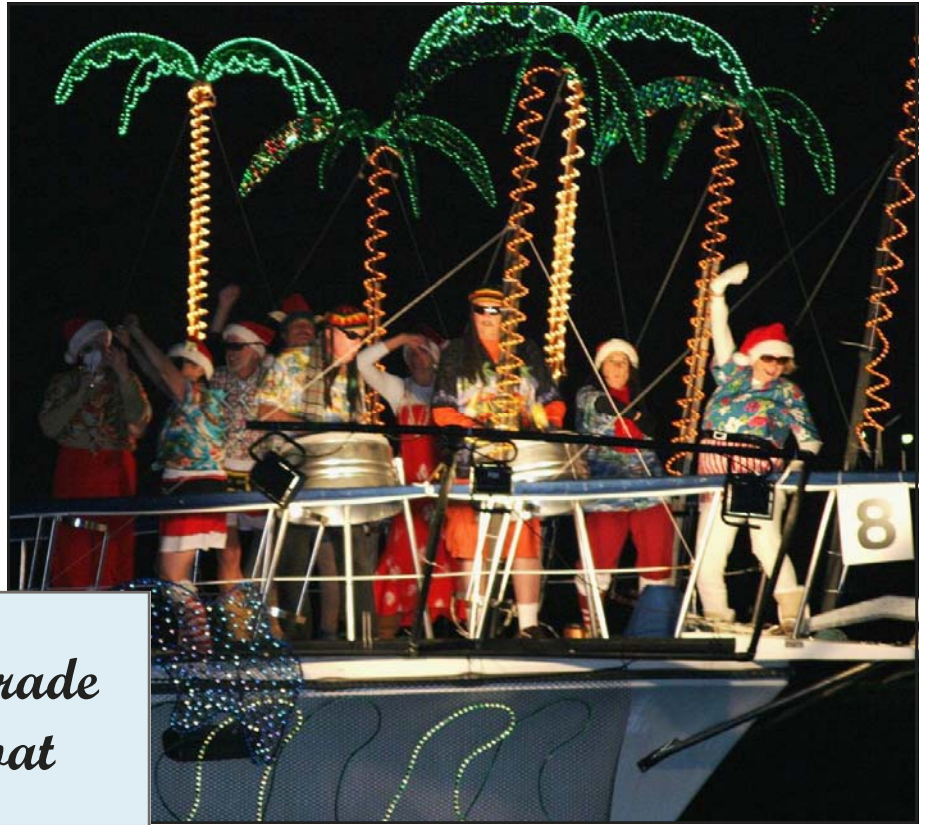
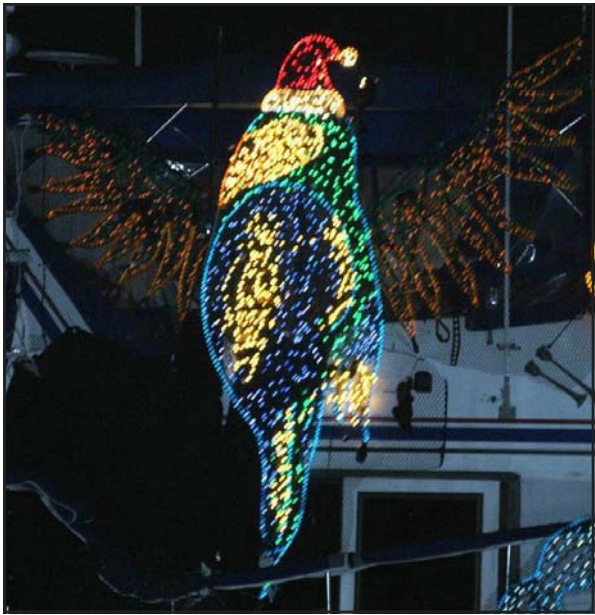

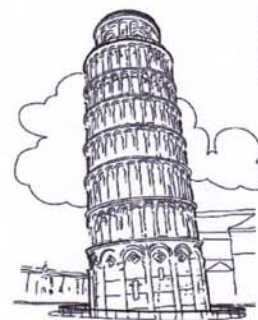
